


# SAFETY

### EMERGENCY - CALL 911



Fire extinguisher

is located behind the passenger seat and next to the side door



First aid kit

is located under the bed in garage storage



LP, smoke, detectors are located above the kitchen countertop.



Travel within the speed limit and in accordance with road and traffic conditions



Do not drive on dirt road (only well maintained) more than 2 miles and keep your speed to 15MPH.



Always fasten your seat belt while driving.



Avoid driving in strong wind and severe weather.



# COCKPIT



## Driving position

On the side of the driver's seat, you will find 2 levers to regulate seating position. Adjust distance from steering wheel, reclining level and lumbar support.

## Safety & Driver Assistance

Standard safety features include a Pro Trailer Backup Assist, adaptive cruise control, forward collision mitigation, and a lane-keeping system. 360-degree camera

## Infotainment & Technology

The Tremor comes standard with a 12-inch infotainment touchscreen featuring SYNC 4 software, wireless Apple CarPlay and Android Auto, and a one-year trial of Connected Navigation. It also includes a 12-inch digital gauge cluster

## Gps

Ford is equipped with Gps navigation system and owners can locate Campervan anytime and also remotely unlock doors in case of emergency.



# DEPARTURE CHECKLIST

Retract the awning and lower the antenna completely.

Put away any loose items, lock all the cabinets doors. Put down toilet seat and lid. Close all the windows and vents.

Turn off all the lights and the AC/heater and water heater.

Disconnect all the hookups (water, electricity, sewage) and remove leveling equipment.

Release emergency break, put Tow Mode on and hit the road!



# SETTING UP A CAMP

## CHOOSE RIGHT SPOT

Look for the spot that will fit a 30' vehicle. Preferably use spotter outside. Check the surrounding first!

Try to choose level spot. Use leveling blocks when necessary. They are stored in the rear storage.

Turn off the engine and engage the parking brake.

## EXTRAS

Put on cab window cover and lock the cab doors.





# WASTE DUMPING

The freshwater tank holds your clean water.  
This is the RV water tank that supplies  
water to your RV sink and shower.



The gray water tank  
holds the dirty water  
from your shower and  
sinks.

The RV black water tank  
contains wastewater and  
sewage from your RV  
toilet.

**DUMP WHEN TANKS ARE 3/4 FULL OR AT THE END OF A TRIP.  
FIRST BLACK TANK THEN GREY ONE - ALWAYS!**

1. Park near sewer drain. Close the RV's windows and vents to keep noxious smells and fumes outdoors.
2. Secure the L shaped end of the hose to the valve at the sewer line or dumping station. Next, hook up hose to the black tank valve on the side of the RV.
3. Pull the black water tank valve handle located next to sewer hose connection to empty the toilet waste first. Allow it to drain completely. Close the black tank valve.
4. Repeat for the gray water tank.
5. Disconnect hose from RV, lift it to drain any remaining water into the dump inlet and rinse by connecting to the dump station's water supply - NEVER USE RV FRESH WATER!

**NEVER PUT ANYTHING IN THE BLACK WATER TANK OTHER THAN BIODEGRADABLE RV TOILET PAPER. ALSO, DON'T BE PUTTING ANY FOOD IN THE KITCHEN SINK! REMEMBER, THE GRAY HOLDING TANK SYSTEM CAN GET CLOGGED TOO!**

## How to travel safely with your Truck with Roofnest

Perform walk-around visual inspection before embarking on trip. A pre-trip checklist should include things like

- look under rig for signs of fluid leaks
- Release parking brake
- Inspect tires
  
- Check your surroundings (weather, overhangs and ground hazards)

Practice SAFE cornering

- Slowly approach the turn. It's much easier to maneuver a corner with a lower speed.

Know your height

Avoid unexpected blowouts

- Watch your tire pressure. Both under and over inflation can lead to blowouts. To help prevent this, check your tire pressure before you start your trip. You can access tire pressure on driver display.
  
- Fuel capacity 36 gallons **REGULAR UNLEADED GAS 91 OCTANE**



# EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

---

## BREAKDOWN

- Pull over to safe location and turn on Hazard lights.
- Assess the situation and call roadside assistance if necessary

## FIRE

- If fire occurs, immediately turn off all appliances and exit the vehicle
- Use the fire extinguisher if safe to do so, otherwise move to a safe distance and call emergency services 911

## ACCIDENT

- Ensure everyone is safe and call 911
- Document the accident with photos exchange information with other driver and collect witness statements and information (insurance and ID)

# BEFORE DROP OFF

---

1

- Take all your personal items.
- Double check that you've packed up all your belongings from bathroom, kitchen and beside beds storage.

2

- Empty the fridge.
- Wash all the dishes and wipe countertops.
- Sweep the floors.
- Empty all the trash.

3

- Empty black and gray water tanks if applicable.
- fill water tank if applicable.
- Take all of your belongings from rear storage.
- Clean grill (if used).
- Fill fuel tank **REGULAR UNLEADED GAS 91 OCTANE**


